

Middle School Dress Code (6th – 8th Grade)

FOR THE LADIES:

Skirts / Jumpers

Tommy Hilfiger navy plaid Skirts / Jumpers to be purchased through Tommy Hilfiger (“modesty” shorts to be worn underneath).

Shirts

Blouses

Worn under jumper. They must be light blue or white. Can be purchased from any store.

Polos

Must be navy, light blue or white. Polos may be purchased from any store. Iron-on IHC School logos are required and can be purchased at the school's main office.

Button-Up Sweaters

Button up sweaters can be worn over uniforms but must be Navy blue and have IHC logo patch.

Fleeces

Pullover Navy Fleeces can be worn over uniform tops but must have IHC logos and should be purchased through the Tommy Hilfiger Site. Navy crew neck or Vneck sweaters with IHC logos are also allowed over uniform tops (must be visible).

Pants

Must be khaki color and have belt loops (no pull on or elastic waist bands or cargo pockets). Pants may be purchased from any store.

Shorts

Bermuda style/length and must be khaki in color may be worn from September - October & April - June.

Belts

Belts must be worn with pants and shorts and should be brown or black in color (basic web style or leather - no writing or studs).

Socks

Navy, black, or white dress socks or gym socks are acceptable. Socks must be visible above the top of the shoe and have no patterns or logos. One small logo will be allowed (ex. Nike “swoosh”, Under Armor logo, etc.). Words, large logos, stripes, and multiple logos constitute a pattern and are prohibited. Solid navy-blue tights without patterns may be worn with skirts in colder months. Tights may be worn, but no footless leggings.

Shoes

Allowed:

Dress shoes or sneakers and neutral in color (brown, black, tan, navy blue, or gray). Sperry's and boat shoes are acceptable. No other color is allowed for sneakers worn during the regular school day. Other sneakers are only acceptable in PE class. White-soled sneaker style shoes (Vans, Nike, etc.) are allowed.

Not Allowed:

Canvas sneakers and shoes, including "Hey Dudes" are not allowed. Slides, Crocs, slippers, moccasins, and boots are not allowed during regular school days.

Dress-Down Days:

On dress-down days, sneakers of any color combination are allowed, as well as Crocs or any closed-toe shoe with a back. "Slides", flip-flops, slippers, moccasins, Birkenstocks, and sandals are not permitted.

FOR THE GENTLEMEN:

Pants

Khaki pants (any brand).

Brown, blue, or black pants are not part of the dress code. Pants must be no shorter than ankle length, have regular cuffs (no elastic), and not “jean style.” This means no outside or “patch” pockets, rivets, or denim material. A solid colored black or brown belt must be worn.

Shorts

Shorts must be Khaki color. Allowed be worn from September - October & April - June.

Shirts

Polos

Must be navy, light blue or white. Polos may be purchased from any store. Iron on IHC School logos are required and can be purchased at the school's main office.

Fleeces

Pullover Navy Fleeces can be worn over uniform tops but must have IHC logos and should be purchased through the Tommy Hilfiger Site. Navy Blue crew or V-Neck sweaters may also be worn over the uniform tops and must have IHC patch. Uniform shirts must be visible.

Socks

Navy, black, or white dress socks or gym socks are acceptable. Socks must be visible above the top of the shoe and have no patterns or logos. One small logo will be allowed (ex. Nike “swoosh”, Under Armor logo, etc.). Words, large logos, stripes, and multiple logos constitute a pattern and are prohibited.

Shoes

Allowed:

Dress shoes or sneakers and neutral in color (brown, black, tan, navy blue, or gray). Sperry’s and boat shoes are acceptable. No other color is allowed for sneakers worn during the regular school day. Other sneakers are only acceptable in PE class. White-soled sneaker style shoes (Vans, Nike, etc.) are allowed.

Not Allowed:

Canvas sneakers and shoes, including “Hey Dudes” are not allowed. Slides, Crocs, slippers, moccasins, and boots are not allowed during regular school days.

Dress-Down Days:

On dress-down days, sneakers of any color combination are allowed, as well as Crocs or any closed-toe shoe with a back. “Slides”, flip-flops, slippers, moccasins, Birkenstocks, and sandals are not permitted.
