**** 9th- 12 Religion:** 1 subject green notebook and folder. 1 package of wide spaced lined paper.

- **All: 9th-12th students: 1 box tissues & 1 ream copy paper (turn into homeroom)**

9th grade Global Folder or Small Binder (1 inch)- Heavy-duty or plastic folders are preferred over paper folders. Paper folders do not stand up to carrying a year's worth of notes and assignments. A three-hole punch is available for students with binders.

9th-12 Math:

- **Algebra 1 and 2:** Notebook, Loose leaf paper, folder, pens/pencils.
**Graphing calculator* (required for NY State Regent's examination. Students really benefit from having their own in order to become familiar with it. The same calculator can be used for all high school and collegiate math courses. A list of approved calculators for NY State Regents exams is listed at bottom)
- **Geometry:** Notebook, Loose leaf paper, folder, pens/pencils.
**A compass* (recommend a compass with a locking system and threaded wheel. Compasses without a lock or threaded wheel have a tendency to loosen up making it difficult to use)
**Graphing calculator* (required for NY State Regent's examination. Students greatly benefit from having their own in order to become familiar with it. The same calculator can be used for all high school and collegiate math courses. A list of approved calculators for NY State Regents exams listed below)
- **AP Statistics:** Notebook, Loose leaf paper, pens/pencils.
Graphing calculator (required for AP Statistics Examination). Any calculator with graphing and statistical capabilities authorized. Recommend TI-84 models, as they provide a few extra inference test than a TI-83, however if the student already owns a TI-83 from previous regents courses, it is very capable for this course and exam.
- **Physics:** Notebook, Loose leaf folder, pens/pencils.
Scientific or graphic calculator (required for NY State Regent's examination). If students have a TI-83/84 from previous math courses, its preferred they continue to use that. If a calculator is purchased, cheaper scientific calculators will suffice for the Physics course and exam.
*Physics tool kit: Ensure the kit includes, protractor, compass and ruler with centimeter markings.
