About VHS at Immaculate Heart Central School

For the 2019- 2020 school year, Immaculate Heart Central School has partnered with Virtual High School (VHS) to offer selected 6-12 grade students the opportunity to expand their educational experience and participate in an online course that is not offered at IHC.

The Virtual High School and/or its programs/courses are accredited by The Middle States Association, AdvancED, and the NCAA. Flex and summer courses are not NCAA approved.

What Students and Parents Need to Know

- Fifteen VHS “seats” are available for the 2019- 2020 school year for each semester. Students who wish to take VHS must meet the course prerequisites, complete an interview, and be granted approval from Lynise Lassiter, Principal, and Karen Montondo, VHS Site Coordinator. One student has already signed up! We still have 14 ½ seats left.
- One Free VHS course per student per semester or year. Families will have to pay for additional courses. Families will have to pay for the extra classes once the seat is taken.
- VHS does not replace an in-house requirement for Language, Science, English, Social Studies, Math or Religious Studies. Credit is given for courses chosen to fulfill an elective or non-Regents requirement. Possible exceptions will be made for students with severe schedule conflicts.
- Some VHS courses are one semester in length; others are full-year courses. Students who enroll in a one-semester VHS course may choose to take a 2nd VHS class the other semester. Students may elect to keep only one semester of VHS and have a study the other semester.
- Students who enroll in an AP course through VHS must follow the AP policies established by Immaculate Heart Central School and VHS and are required to take the AP examination in May.
- There is a \$100 fee for all AP courses. It is also the responsibility of the families to pay the student’s AP exam fee.
- The VHS course grade is included for class standing.
- Students who fail a VHS course must reimburse the school 100% of the tuition.
- There is no charge for the textbooks. Students will have access to e-versions for the entire semester or year. However, printed copies are available for students with special needs.
